The training for this certification provides familiarization with all HP BladeSystem products, with an emphasis on break-fix troubleshooting.

This certification is aimed at Service technicians who already hold the certification APS – HP BladeSystem [2007]

APS – HP BladeSystem [2009] replaces APS – HP BladeSystem [2007], which cannot be acquired after 15 January 2010. Because of the new content in the training course and the numerous updates in the products and programs, all candidates for the [2009] certification should complete the new training and must complete the exam HP2-T15.

Why earn this certification:

Since their introduction just a few short years ago, more than a million HP BladeSystems have been purchased by customers all around the world. This should come as no surprise. Because a BladeSystem is an infrastructure in a box, customers can build vital solutions to support their businesses—solutions that are more affordable, take less time to maintain, use less power and are ready to grow with the business. Given the vast number of product updates and new product introductions in recent years, the maintenance technician who holds the [2007] version of this certification will find it beneficial to update to the [2009] version.
